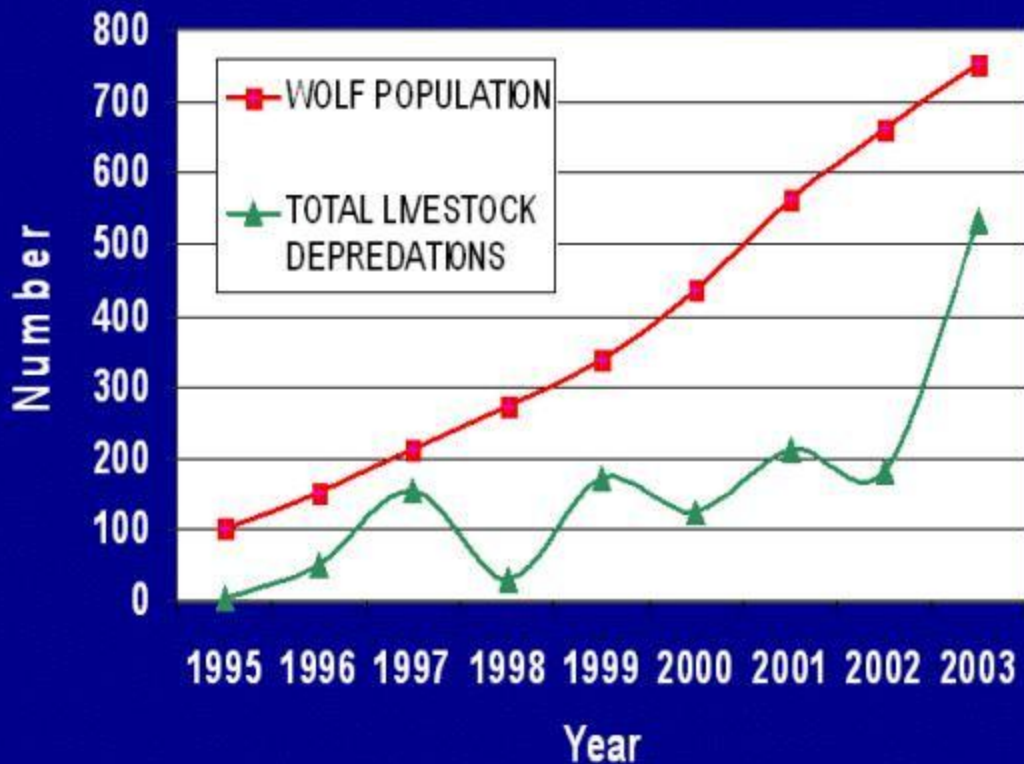

<u>Central Idaho</u>	<b>\$78.00 per wolf</b>
<u>Northwest Montana</u>	<b>\$86.00 per wolf</b>
Wisconsin (2003)	<b>\$56.00 per wolf</b>
Southwest (Mexican gray wolf)	<b>\$284.00 per wolf</b>
Spain (Iberian wolf)	<b>\$1,375.00 per wolf</b>
Canada (20 <sup>th</sup> century bounties)	<b>\$269.00 per wolf</b>
Alaska (helicopter lethal control)	<b>\$1,169.00 per wolf</b>

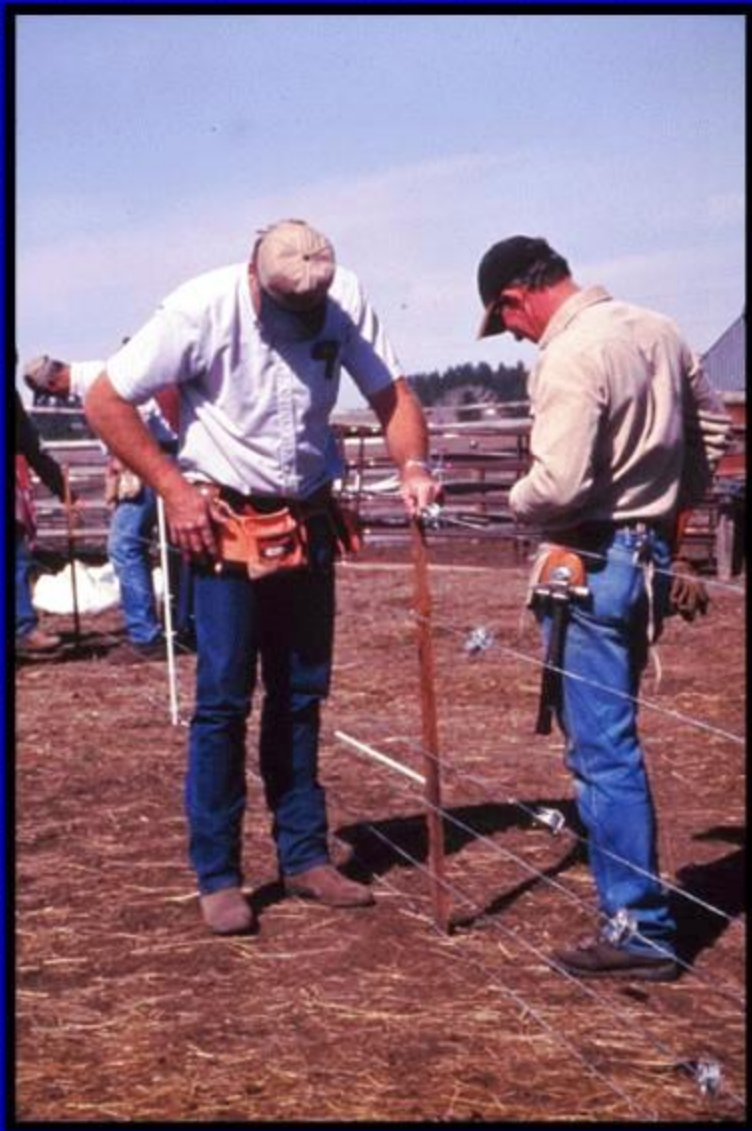
# Objectives of Bailey Wildlife Foundation Proactive Carnivore Conservation Fund

- To increase general tolerance for carnivores across the landscape
